Participation Terms

This section must be read and signed by you and your parent(s).

1. While in Canada, I am always under the jurisdiction of the national, provincial, and local laws. I will obey all the laws. If I break the law (shoplifting, stealing, etc.) it will result in my termination from the program.
2. I will obey the rules of the school I attend. These rules include, but not limited to, attendance and actively participating in classroom work. I agree to take part in extra-curricular activities.
3. I will obey the rules of my home stay. This includes any curfews, chores and other rules they have established.
4. I will make every effort to adjust to, and become a member of, the host family and community.
5. I will keep the Host Family informed at all times of my whereabouts, with whom I am associating, and times of departure from and return to the Host Family's home.
6. I agree to discuss any difficulties I may have to my schoolteacher, host parents, host family coordinator and/or program supervisor before I call my parents.
7. I agree to call my parents or get a phone call from my parents no more than once a week, every Friday between 8:00p.m. and 10:00p.m.(Atlantic Canada time), if needed.
8. **Travel within Nova Scotia** - I understand that with the permission of my host family, I can travel throughout the province with them, a student group or other family.

Travel outside of Nova Scotia – I understand that I require approval from the ISEP to travel outside the province with a group or my host family. I will also advise the ISEP at least two weeks prior to my departure of my plans to travel

9. I understand that there is no guarantee made with the placement in a certain school, grade level, and a particular Host Family, and the School Board and the host family coordinators will place it.
10. I will not borrow money from the Host Family or from any other source. My parents will supply me with an adequate amount of spending money at all times, it is approximately \$100-\$200 per month.
11. I understand that visits by members of my family from my home country are permitted no sooner than six weeks after my arrival in Nova Scotia. If my families visit, they are responsible to make arrangements for their lodging outside the home of my host family.
12. As the parents of an ISEP student,
 - I authorize the host parents and/or the ISEP (host family coordinator, school board and program supervisor) to make medical and health care decisions in emergency situations when I (we) cannot be contacted in time for such decisions.
 - I agree that my child has permission to engage in all prescribed program activities include schools and host families.
 - I understand and agree that we are responsible for all current and future claims, charges, costs of loss property, personal injury, illness, accident or death sustained by the participant for the duration of the ISEP, whether its covered by current insurance or not.

Program termination: The ISEP reserves the right to terminate participation for the violation of program rules and/or when a participant's mental and/or physical health, as determined solely by the ISEP, are/is in jeopardy. Students who are expelled from the ISEP will not be given a refund.

I understand that I am expected to follow and obey all the terms stated. I also understand that if I do not, I will be sent back to my home country immediately at my own expense.
