ISEP Program - one ISEP student per classroom - one Canadian host family

Sessions

There are three sessions.

Summer: Jul - Sep (8 / 12 Weeks)

Fall: Oct - Feb (8 / 12 / 20 Weeks)

Winter: Jan - Feb (8 Weeks)

For students who are attending this program for the first and second time,

a session can be 8 weeks or 12 weeks long.

For students who had attended in this program more than three times,

a session can be 20 weeks long.



Schools

The program is associated with 90 public schools in the Chignecto-Central Regional School Board.

The schools are located within two hour driving distance from

Halifax, the capital of Nova Scotia.

Host Families

Each principal provides a host family list to a host family coordinator.

Matches of students to host families are then made by a host family coordinator and monitored by the school board and ISEP.
